All necessary procedures and precautions will be implemented to insure the highest quality semen possible. Sires will be handled carefully and treated by a local qualified veterinarian in the event of any sickness or injury, at the owner's expense.

It is mutually understood by the sire's owners, Hawkeye Breeders Services, Inc. and their employees or associates that they do hereby mutually release each other from any and all liability in the event of injury or death of the sire(s), damage to semen during collection, of above-named sire, or from any injury sustained by Hawkeye Breeders Service, Inc., employees or associates while handling said sire(s).

Owner agrees to pay all charges for services rendered and any extra costs incurred (vet charges, fitting, photography, classifying and sexed semen) within 30 days of billing. Owner agrees to pay interest on all past due amounts at the rate of 1.5% per month of the unpaid balance (or the maximum permitted by law, if less) from the invoice due date; and Hawkeye Breeder Services, Inc. may suspend services until full payment of the amount due has been received. Owner agrees to reimburse Hawkeye Breeders Service, Inc. for all costs (including reasonable attorneys' fees) incurred in enforcing the terms of this Contract and/or any associated with the collection of amounts owed by Owner to Hawkeye Breeders Service, Inc.

This Contract will be governed by the laws of the State of Iowa and Owner irrevocably consents to the exclusive jurisdiction of the state court located in Dallas County, Iowa, or any federal court located in the State of Iowa for all purposes in connection with any action or proceeding which arises out of or relates to this Contract.

All outstanding charges must be resolved prior to removal of sire(s) or semen from stud and/or semen released. Owner expressly grants to Hawkeye Breeders Service a security interest in the bull made the subject of this contract and semen collected and/or stored by Hawkeye Breeders Service for any charges not paid under this agreement. **All semen remaining with unpaid storage for more than 1 storage billing cycle will be considered abandoned and will become property of Hawkeye Breeders Service, Inc. and Hawkeye Breeders Service, Inc. has right to destroy or sell any and all semen stored after the unpaid billing cycle.**

Hawkeye Breeders Services does not carry insurance on your sire(s) and/or semen collected while at our facility. Owner/Agent agree to maintain mortality or other insurance as they deem necessary to protect them from loss of the bull and/or his semen. Please note: It is highly suggested that the sire(s) listed above be Blood Typed or DNA tested.

CSS does not mean it is necessarily exportable semen. CSS (minimum qualifying) semen begins approximately 10 days after testing has begun (this does not mean 10 days after the sire has arrived at our facility) Minimally qualifying CSS semen can be used for exporting embryos internationally and the semen can be shipped all over the United States.

Every country requires at least a minimum residency of 60 days (after testing has started) before exportable semen can be collected.

Europe requires a minimum residency (after testing begins) of 70 days prior to semen becoming exportable.

Hawkeye Breeders Service, Inc. will now be invoicing all veterinary charges. International testing will be started on all entering bulls but vet charges must be paid within 14 days of the invoice date or testing will cease and you could be invoiced for restarting the testing.

Many countries require a post test at least 28 days after the last collection date in order to finish qualifying for export.
